



Deasbad 2015

These four teams will take part in the semi-finals which take place at the Scottish Storytelling Centre in Edinburgh on Tuesday the 24th of November with the finals taking place the following evening and going out live on BBC Radio nan Gàidheal from the Scottish Parliament.

It was agreed that the new format for the competition was a success. Every team had the opportunity to debate twice and points were given out to each school following their debates. The four teams with the highest points after the first two rounds progressed through to the final stages of this prestigious competition.
